- Mastering the Aleph Integrated Library System, two different OPAC/discovery layers, and embarking on a fourth iteration library system, currently in process.
- Acting as Institutional Lead for the SUNY Alma/Primo migration (July 2018 June 2019), beginning with Brockport's role as a Vanguard Institution (August 2017 to present).
- Serving on the SUNY-wide Data Migration Task Force for same.
- Migrating campus-hosted web proxy service to OCLC-hosted service.
- Collaborating with Library and classroom faculty on myriad projects and student assignments.
- Providing bibliographic instruction and embedded librarian services.
- Developing, operating and frequently presenting on the Library's Makerspace, and Tech Tools collection.
- Hiring, training and mentoring several Makerspace and Tech Tools students, including Scholar's Day sponsorships.
- Volunteering annually for Commencement, the Diversity Conference, the Veteran's Day Committee, among others, often providing live-stream services.
- Offering support, training and leadership to several Library and campus departments, whether part of his official duties, or not.

Ken is a generous, professional, productive, curious, cheerful member of the Library faculty, and we look forward to working with him on future endeavors.
